From Asheville, take I-40 West to exit 27 (US 74 west towards Waynesville). Continue on US 74 west to NC 28 in Almond (48 miles). Follow NC 28 to just east of Red Barn Hollow Road (project terminus). Follow NC 28 to NC 143 into Robbinsville. Follow US 129 south just south of Five Point Road (project terminus).

STIP Project A-0009C involves improving US 129, NC 143, and NC 28 by widening the pavement to include climbing/passing lanes throughout and improving shoulders.


